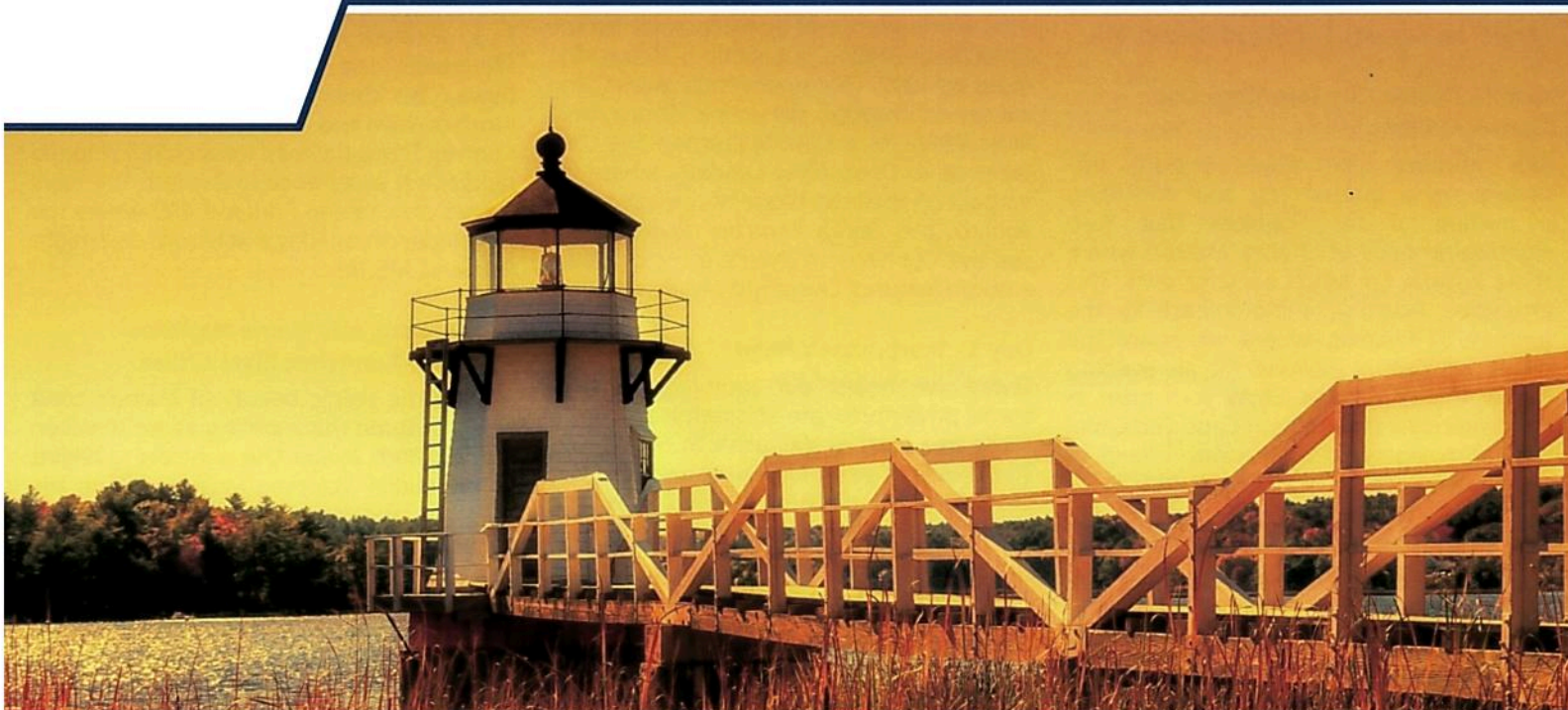

Steam Train and the *Becky Thatcher Riverboat*. History comes to life once more at Old Sturbridge Village. Take another look at the fall hues from Lake Winnepesaukee, soak in the scenes from the famous Kancamagus Scenic Byway and take in the red, yellow and orange brilliance from the *Conway Scenic Railroad*. The tour concludes in Maine, where we enjoy one last scenic cruise, a tour of a marine museum and a traditional lobster dinner. Autumn on the East Coast has never been more memorable.

Day 1 - Boston

Arrive in Boston today, check in to your hotel and take the remainder of the day to explore the city on your own. Meet your tour manager at the hotel for a brief meeting before heading out to dinner at your choice of local restaurants. Overnight Boston, MA.

Day 2 - Boston City Tour/Cape Cod Central Railroad

This morning, learn about Boston's rich history on a guided city tour including a portion of the Freedom Trail. Your sightseeing ends at Quincy Market, where there is time for lunch on your own. This afternoon, board your motorcoach for the journey to Hyannis, where we board the *Cape Cod Central Railroad* for an evening dinner train excursion. Enjoy your meal as the train crosses the famous Cape Cod Canal railroad bridge into the historic village of Buzzard's Bay. Overnight Hyannis, MA. (B, D)

Day 3 - Martha's Vineyard

Today's excursion takes us aboard the *M/V Island Home*, a passenger and vehicle ferry which crosses from Cape Cod to Martha's Vineyard. Once on the island, enjoy tales of its fishing and whaling past, shopping and dining opportunities in the charming town of Edgartown and a visit to the colorful Victorian gingerbread cottages of Oak Bluffs (time permitting). Later, we return by ferry to Woods Hole, MA, and on to Hyannis. Overnight Hyannis, MA. (B)

Day 4 - Mystic Seaport Museum, Essex Steam Train and the Becky Thatcher Riverboat

Marvel at the fiery colors of fall as we travel inland this morning bound for Mystic, CT.

Our destination is Mystic Seaport, a maritime museum that was founded in 1929 and tells the nautical history of the Eastern Seaboard through fascinating exhibits and immersive experiences.

Afterwards, we travel by motorcoach to the Essex Train Station, a historic building that dates to 1892. Our steam train awaits, and we set off through the scenic Connecticut River Valley for a 12-mile journey. The train takes us to Deep River Landing, where we embark on the next phase of our adventure aboard the *Becky Thatcher Riverboat* to see the Connecticut River's most beautiful autumn features. Overnight Mystic, CT. (B, L)

Day 5 - Sturbridge Village

Today, we board our motorcoach for a scenic drive north into Massachusetts. Enjoy some free time as we arrive in Sturbridge. The charm of years long past awaits at Old Sturbridge Village today. During your time at Old Sturbridge, you have a chance to walk through the historic buildings in the village, and to explore more than 50,000 period artifacts. Then reconvene with your fellow travelers for a traditional New England dinner at the Salem Cross Inn. Overnight Sturbridge, MA. (B, D)

Day 6 - Travel Day

Our beautiful route through the colors of the East continues as we drive to the edge of White Mountain National Forest. Overnight Plymouth, NH. (B)

Day 7 - Lake Winnepesaukee Cruise

We travel to Weirs Beach this morning to board the MS Mount Washington for a cruise on Lake Winnepesaukee. Step off the vessel and into the charming village of Wolfeboro,

NH where the remainder of the day is at your leisure. Overnight Plymouth, NH. (B)

Day 8 - Conway Scenic Railroad

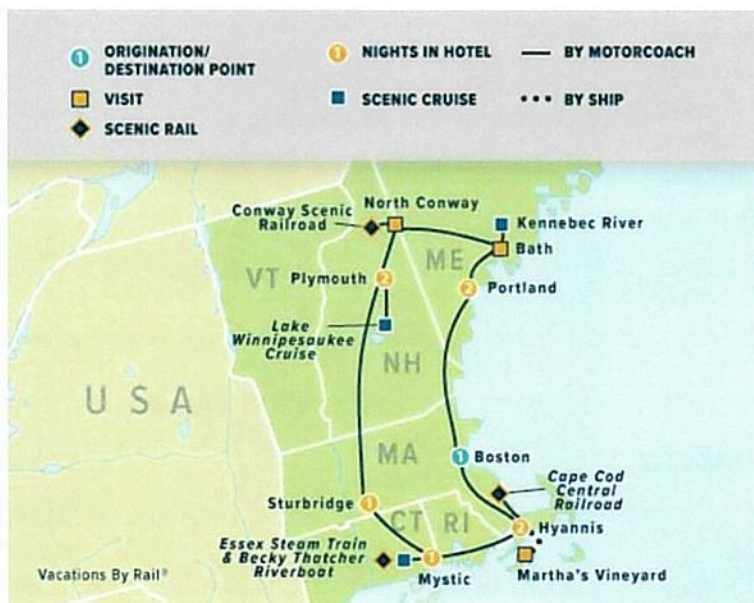
Keep your camera within reach this morning as we travel through Franconia North State Park, located in the heart of the White Mountains, via the Kancamagus Scenic Byway. We continue to North Conway for lunch on our own and time to explore. Board the *Conway Scenic Railroad* for an old-fashioned railroading experience to Bartlett. The day's travels conclude in Portland, ME, where the remainder of your day is at leisure. Overnight Portland, ME. (B)

Day 9 - Bath, ME/ Maine Maritime Museum/ Kennebec River Cruise

Admire the scenic beauty of Maine's coast in the autumn this morning as we travel en route to Bath, Maine. Our sightseeing begins at the Maine Maritime Museum. From the museum, we step aboard a river cruiser for an up-close look at the Kennebec River and the sites along it. The first landmark we pass is the Bath Iron Works. A retired Bath Iron Works employee joins us on board to discuss his experience as a shipbuilder. As we continue down the Kennebec, we pass the 1898 Doubling Point Lighthouse and the Kennebec River Range Light Station before returning to the museum. Enjoy lunch and shopping on your own before we return to Portland. The afternoon is yours to enjoy in the Old Wharf District. This evening is highlighted by a lobster dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight Portland, ME. (B, D)

Day 10 - Tour Conclusion

Your fall foliage vacation concludes this morning. A group transfer to Boston Logan Airport will accommodate flights departing after 1:00 pm. (B)
