At 3:00 pm, everyone will go to the Solomon Victory Theater for the documentary screening of "The Six Triple Eight", a film that explores the history and service of the 6888th Central Postal Directory Battalion, the only all black female battalion to serve in Europe during World War II.

The bus will depart for home at 5:00 pm and arrive home around 7:00 pm. You may bring snacks on the bus if you wish.
